Perhaps the most effective way to counter this is to highlight Jewish voices. I have not had a lot of time for writing this month, so in lieu of reading my micro-research paper about Jewish Americans, let's listen to some of their voices. As a federally recognized heritage month, there are governmental resources about Jewish American history, successes, and present challenges.
