We need volunteers in every area of the church and each has its own commitment level.

SUNDAY MORNINGS

_____ **Sunday School teacher/helpers: 9:00 am** Teach the young children the message of GOD. You will have all the supplies you need and the Curriculum in advance if you need to make any changes. We need 2 people in each room. We need at least 1 adult (over 18), and the second person can be 6th grade and up for each class. You do not need to commit to every week. If we have enough volunteers, we can share the time!

_____ **Children’s Church, helper: 10:30 am** After the Children’s Message during Worship, Children will come to Children’s Church and we will have a small lesson. We will go outside (weather permitting) We need 2 people in each room. We need at least 1 adult (over 18), and the second person can be 6th grade and up for each class. You do not need to commit to every week. If we have enough volunteers, we can share the time!

_____ **Counters:** Help count the money that has come in through the week and during Sunday morning worship. You can come in at 10:30 am. We have 2 people counting each Sunday.

_____ **Hospitality Team:** we are bringing back the snack in the gathering space on Sunday mornings and need people to help with set up (plates, napkins) and then clean up after the last worship hour. We also need help to set up and clean up when we have Church potlucks.

_____ **Welcome Desk:** Greet people warmly as they enter the church and help visitors find SS rooms, sanctuary, restrooms, etc. Volunteers need to arrive about 20 minutes before services begin and arrange their own schedule using an online sign-up. Training provided.

_____ **Ushers:** Greet people entering the sanctuary, give bulletins and assist with seating, as necessary. Ushers help collect offering, help with directing people for communion and straighten-up chairs after services end. Ushers are also important in emergency situations. Generally, ushers choose either a certain Sunday each month (e.g., first or second) or one month per quarter to serve at a given service. Training provided.

_____ **Liturgists:** Lead the congregation in the Call to Worship and read the scripture. A good public speaking voice is helpful. Liturgists generally serve once every two months. Training provided.

EVENTS/SPECIAL HAPPENINGS

_____ **Funeral Reception Teams:** We need a few more people willing to provide food when a funeral reception is held at church. We generally are looking for cookies, veggie and fruit trays, and cheese and crackers or small sandwiches. You would be called when there is a reception. You can always say no if the date does not work for you.

YOUTH PROGRAM (each option can be once a month or on a regular basis)

_____ **Service Project leaders:** help lead service projects - Once a month on Sunday 6-8

_____ **Small Group Leader:** help run activities and discussions for middle schoolers - Sundays 6-8

_____ **Youth Group Leader:** help run activities and discussions - Sundays 6-8

MUSIC

_____ **Chancel Choir:** Any high school student or adult is welcome ~ whether you read music or not. We meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:45-8:30 p.m. The choir sings in worship from September through May. If you enjoy singing, this is a wonderful group to join and grow your faith through the ministry of music in a group setting.

_____ **Praise Team:** We need a drummer/percussionist and a bass guitarist currently. The Praise Team sings contemporary Christian music. If you enjoy singing or play the piano, we welcome your talents.

_____ **Instrumentalists:** Brass, string and woodwind players are welcomed. Any high schooler (with one or two years' experience) or adult is welcome to play as a soloist or in a group setting for worship services throughout the year. Rehearsal schedules vary.

_____ **Handbell Ringers:** Whether you are experienced or not, handbell ringers or new-to-handbell ringers are welcome. Children ages 6-11. Youth 6th-12th grade. Adults, experienced or not. Circle one: Want to learn to ring or you have some experience at ringing

_____ **Filing:** We are in need of individuals who enjoy filing and organizing. Dates and times are flexible to your schedule. Training provided.

_____ **Children's Choir:** Children Kindergarten through fifth grade who enjoy music ~ singing and playing simple instruments (shakers, tambourines, wood blocks, hand chimes). Sundays 9:30 - 9:55 am.

_____ **Youth Choir:** Sixth grade and up who enjoy music ~ singing and playing simple instruments (shakers, tambourines, wood blocks, hand chimes). Rehearsal schedule varies.
